Introduction to Harmony

- Harmony is the study of how different notes are related to one another and the interaction between notes
- Melody is defined as single notes played one after another
- Harmonies are defined as two different notes played together
- Chords are defined as three or more different notes played together
- Counterpoint is defined as two or more melodies played together
- Triads are the most basic chords they consist of a root, a third, and a fifth played together.
- There are four basic triads: Major, Minor, Augmented, and Diminished
- Playing additional intervals on top of a triad will add color and variation to a chord
- Playing one chord after another is called a progression
